Interest in Accreditation Flourishes in the Pacific Rim

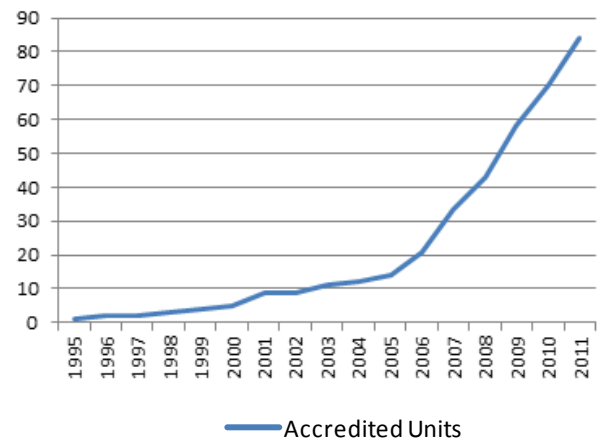


Figure 1. Growth in the number of accredited institutions in the Pacific Rim region.

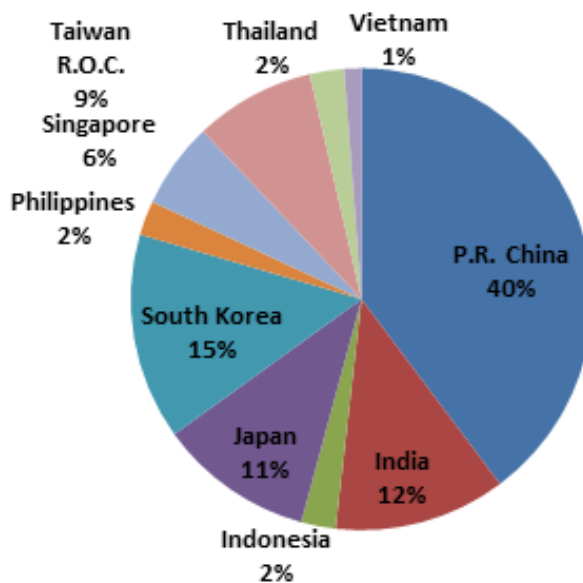


Figure 2. The ten countries in the Pacific Rim region that have accredited institutions.

Interest in the AAALAC International accreditation program is flourishing in the Pacific Rim region. The number of accredited institutions in the Pacific Rim region continues to grow at a steady pace (Figure 1 below). Two-thirds of all international applications for accreditation originate from institutions located in the Pacific Rim, and these applications represent just under one-third of all new applications. Currently there are 83 AAALAC accredited institutions in ten Pacific Rim countries including India, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Philippines, P.R. China, Singapore, Taiwan R.O.C., Thailand and Vietnam (Figure 2 next page).

Due to the growing interest in AAALAC International accreditation from organizations throughout the Pacific Rim region, plans are underway to open additional regional offices in order to expand services to those areas. **Dr. Montip Gettayacamin** works in the new Southeast Asia Regional office in Bangplee District, Samutprakarn Province, Thailand. **Dr. Kathryn Bayne** is AAALAC's Global Director. 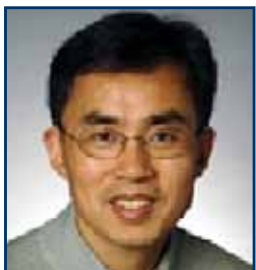

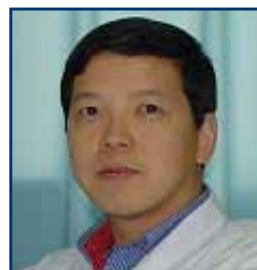
